The Denver Area Al-Anon /Alateen Service Center provides a variety of resources and services to facilitate hope, recovery and serenity to family members and friends of problem drinkers. We encourage members to experience the miracles of recovery and growth through participation in Al-Anon/Alateen meetings and service opportunities.

The Denver Area Service began in 1972

Our initial office was shared with the AA Central Office and our rent was \$60 a month. Fundraising began soon after so that we could support ourselves. An Al-Anon member donated money for our first year of phone costs.

A shower was hosted for the service center and the theme was “A Baby was Born” .

Soon after a monthly potluck began on Sunday nights called ‘Family Affair’.

In August of 1972 Lois W. was passing through Denver and was invited to speak at the monthly meeting. She spoke to a crowd of 100 delighted people.

In 1976 a part time office coordinator was hired and a mimeograph machine was purchased.

...and here we are today....still serving the greater Denver area!

Primary Functions of the Denver Area

Al-Anon/Alateen Service Center

- Provide communications via a monthly Newsletter to the member groups we serve informing them of upcoming events, speaker meetings and new meetings started in the Denver Area.
- Maintain a listing of current local Denver Area Al-Anon/Alateen meetings.
- Serve as an Intergroup Information source.
- Provide Conference Approved Literature for sale to the members we serve.
- Coordinate outreach requests, with the appropriate Districts/Area coordinators whenever needed.
- Answer e-mail and phone inquires, referring people to the nearest meetings and direct them to the Colorado Area web site.
- Maintain a volunteer staff to assist the Board, and the Service Committee in reaching our objectives.

- To maintain a central business office, to sell CAL literature with help of volunteers,.
