What is this service opportunity all about?

A Service Representative attends a DASC Service Committee meeting once a month on behalf of their group. The meeting is held either at the Denver Area Service Center or via a telephone conference call. Monthly meetings of the Service Committee shall be held to consider interim reports of the Service Board, Standing Committees, and other business.



The Annual meeting in May will be for the election of new officers of the Service Board.

Voting as the Service Committee Representative shall be restricted to one (1) vote per group when present at the Service Committee meeting.

The Function of the DASC Service Committee as defined by the Bylaws of the Denver Area Service Center.

(Service Representative Responsibilities)

- The members of the Service Committee should represent Denver Metro Al-Anon as a whole, bringing the viewpoint of their group.
- Be good will ambassadors
- To meet monthly and review actions of the Service Board and its Standing Committees.
- To approve methods of financial support for the Denver Area Service Center.
- To receive the annual budget recommendations of the Finance Committee, and to approve an annual budget for the Denver Service Center.
- To report on all actions of the Service Committee and its subcommittee to the groups they represent.
- To build and maintain interest of their groups in the Service Committee and its functions.
- To encourage service participation from the member groups.
- To review and enact any amendments to the Procedure Guide by referring to the Policy Guidelines document.
- To approve the Service Board's selection of the Service Center Coordinator and compensation arrangements made by said committee.
- To approve appointments by the Service Board of Standing Committee Chairpersons.
