WSO's Finance Committee Report:

Through June 30, 2019, literature sales have trended 2% higher than budgeted (Intimacy in Alcoholic Relationships sales are holding steady).

WSO received a substantial bequest in May, hence contributions are higher than budget by 8% year-to-date. Without considering the bequest, contributions are at a historic low!
