

## **Skit: God is the Keystone of the new and triumphant arch through which we passed to freedom.**

Bring in arch (helium-filled balloons tied in an arch) On one side of the arch is a lovely scene. The other side is gray.

Two Al-Anons draped in chains enter the stage. They exclaim at the beautiful arch, through which they can see a lovely scene of peace, serenity and freedom. They want to pass through the arch to freedom.

Al-Anon1 bumps into an invisible barrier and is thrown back. S/he says, ***“We’ve got to figure out what the key is to pass through this arch to freedom.”***

They begin to try various keys: 1) Control      2) Guilt      3) Gossip      4) Self-Pity

None works.

Enter from the other side of the stage: An angel holding a golden key. S/he says, ***“Behold... God is the keystone of the new and triumphant arch.”***

Both Al-Anons lift their hands/bow their heads/hug each other – whatever expression means God to them.

As they pass through the arch, their chains fall away and they have a new freedom. ***“Free at last, we are free at last!”***

The Angel says to all, ***“Visit us at the State Convention in Keystone to pass through the new and triumphant arch up to a new level of your freedom!”***

Supplies:      enough helium-filled balloons to create an arch  
                 4 large cardboard keys, gray in color  
                 1 large cardboard key, gold in color  
                 The Al-Anon banner to hang on the side of freedom  
                 Dark material (gray?) to hang on the side of prison  
                 Robe for “angel.” Ragged clothes for Al-Anons; plastic chains
